Series: Even Better

EVEN BETTER THAN THE LAW'S PRIESTHOOD (Hebrews 7:11-28)

Introduction

- 1. How quick are you to adopt new technology? Are you usually open to change, or do you resist it?
- 2. What change have you made in your life that you didn't want to make?

Digging Deeper

- 3. Make 10 observations of your own about Hebrews 7:11-28. What do you notice?
- 4. **Read 1 Samuel 2:12-17.** Not all of the priests of Israel were good, just because they were of a certain line! What was clearly wrong about these priests?
- 5. **Read 1 Samuel 2:27-36.** What judgment was to come on Eli and his sons? What promise comes up in verse 35—and how is it fulfilled in Jesus?
- 6. **Read Isaiah 43:16-21.** What new things did God do in bringing His people out of Egypt and through the wilderness? Did the Israelites always celebrate this new life?
- 7. **Read 2 Corinthians 5:16-21.** Why is this new creation in Christ so important? How did we used to live (verse 16)? How must we live towards others now (verse 20)?
- 8. **Read Revelation 21:1-5.** Do you look forward to God making everything new—even though all we have now will be gone? What's better about what God makes new?
- 9. What did you hear in the message this Sunday that stood out to you? Is there anything you would emphasize, add, or change?

Application

- 10. What has to change in our minds when we release our own ideas of how we're made right with God and trust in His way to save us through Jesus? What makes this change so comprehensive in our lives—and potentially scary?
- 11. What do you need to let go of in order to receive all that Jesus should be in your life?
