# STUDY QUESTIONS FOR MARCH 23

## Series: Even Better

## EVEN BETTER THAN ABRAHAM (Hebrews 7:1-10)

#### Introduction

- 1. When was the last time you *thought* you recognized someone somewhere you didn't expect to see them (e.g. grocery store, park)? Were you right ... or wrong?
- 2. How do you show someone else special respect for their place in your life?

## **Digging Deeper**

- 3. Make 10 observations of your own about Hebrews 7:1-10. What do you notice?
- 4. **CHALLENGE:** Find the paragraph in Genesis about Abram and Melchizedek.<sup>1</sup> Would it be easy to skip over? Why might it have been important to include?
- 5. **Read Numbers 18:21-24.** The Levites were set apart for God's business and given no land to manage, for undivided focus. How do we provide for those committed to God's business today?
- 6. **Read Numbers 18:25-32.** Why is it important for churches and Christian workers today to set a portion of their income aside for God? *(See also 1 Corinthians 16:1-2!)*
- 7. Read Malachi 3:8-10. Who were they robbing by not giving their tithes?
- 8. **Read Luke 24:50-53.** What was Jesus doing before He parted from His disciples? What's the difference between Jesus blessing us and us blessing God?
- 9. Read Ephesians 1:3-10. How has God blessed us in Christ Jesus?
- 10. What did you hear in the message this Sunday that stood out to you? Is there anything you would emphasize, add, or change?

## Application

- 11. What are some familiar "signposts" in the Old Testament that point to Jesus? How can you improve at making connections to Jesus in the Old Testament?
- 12. How are you blessed in Jesus? When was the last time you counted these blessings?
- 13. How do you give tribute to Jesus? How does your giving enable our church to dedicate some of our members fully to His service?
